

Brazil's Urban Planners Studied establishment of Bases for regional medical and welfare of UR

On June 12, 2023, eight participants of Instituto de Pesquisa e Planejamento Urbano de Curitiba (IPPUC), Brazil visited Otokoyama Danchi (housing complex) in Kyoto. The visit was part of the JICA Project for Strengthening the Capacity on Sustainable Urban Development.
