

Australia-Japan networking event in Tokyo

Urban Renaissance Agency (UR) hosted a networking event on Tuesday, October 22, 2024, in Toranomon, Tokyo, aimed at deepening mutual understanding and strengthening the relationship between Japanese and Australian companies.

This event was organized with the support of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT), Japan Australia Business Co-operation Committee (JABCC), and Australia Japan Business Co-operation Committee (AJBCC). The primary objective was to support the participation of Japanese companies in urban development projects in Australia.

In addition to 36 members from 21 Japanese companies and 29 members from 14 Australian companies, representatives from MLIT, the Australian Embassy, and the Victorian State Government also joined the event, contributing to the enhancement of Japan-Australia relations.
