

The 2nd Japan-Indonesia Joint Coordination Meeting for Dukuh Atas Pedestrian Deck Development Held in Jakarta

On September 3, 2026, the Urban Renaissance Agency (“UR”) and PT MRT Jakarta (Perseroda) (“MRTJ”) held the “2nd Japan-Indonesia Joint Coordination Meeting for Pedestrian Deck Development” in Dukuh Atas, Jakarta, with the aim of facilitating smooth pedestrian movement at this major transport node.

Located in Jakarta's Central Business District (CBD), this area serves as a transport hub where five different modes converge. However, these stations are divided by the river and a major road, making it a critical urban and transportation policy to strengthen the transport hub function and revitalize the surrounding area.

After exchanging the Memorandum of Understanding on the promotion of TOD in Jakarta in 2023, and the Minutes of Discussion on the potential collaboration for Dukuh Atas Pedestrian Deck Development in 2024, UR has provided the technical support for MRTJ in the technical studies on the pedestrian deck development and the formation of a coordination meeting among stakeholders to help solve urban challenges in this area.

Following the first meeting held in September 2025, the project has advanced steadily, with the basic design completed by a joint venture that includes a Japanese company and a groundbreaking ceremony held in June 2026.

The second meeting focused on the future expansion of the area-wide pedestrian network and better connections between the deck, nearby stations, bus stops, and surrounding buildings. Participants also discussed long-term development opportunities, stakeholder collaboration, and the potential use of a 3D city model developed under Japan's PLATEAU initiative for deck connection analysis, construction planning, future pedestrian flow analysis, etc.

Representatives from the Indonesian national government, the Jakarta Provincial Government, transport operators, the Embassy of Japan in Indonesia, Japan's Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, JICA, UR, and private-sector organizations joined the meeting both in person and online. UR will continue to support the project by leveraging its extensive experience in urban regeneration, stakeholder coordination, and project implementation to help create a safe and seamless pedestrian network in the Dukuh Atas district.
