

UR gave Keynote Speech and Exhibition at the TOD*1 Forum held in Jakarta, Indonesia

On November 20, the Ikatan Arsitek Indonesia (IAI) Jakarta and "PT Mass Rapid Transit Jakarta (MRTJ) jointly held a TOD Forum in Jakarta, Republic of Indonesia, at the Transport Hub - Auditorium.

TOD Forum began with a declaration of opening by the Chairperson of IAI Jakarta and Mr. Junkichi KANO Chief Representative, Representative office in Jakarta, UR, gave a presentation on the theme of "Sustainable TOD and Urban Planning". More than 200 audiences from many organizations relevant with TOD policy and projects watched the presentations.

* 1 TOD is an acronym stands for Transit Oriented Development.

It refers to urban development that aims to alleviate traffic congestion, promote usage of public transportation such as railway, and to enhance convenience centered on railway stations.

Experts discussed the implications of MRT Jakarta's expansion and its potential to transform the city.

UR will continue to work on the revitalization of TOD in cooperation with Indonesian stakeholders.
